

# Grant Possibility to Support Psychology Student Training in Community Health Centers

Through a grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) is offering sites and students a chance to participate in the California Student/Resident Experiences and Rotations in Community Health (Cal-SEARCH).

Community based organizations that successfully apply to Cal-SEARCH would receive \$1,000 per supervised student. Students who successfully apply to Cal-SEARCH would receive a \$665 stipend upon completion of rotation, community project and receipt of post-rotation documentation.

Only health care sites that are in Health Manpower Shortage Areas are eligible to apply for these funds.

The first cycle of the program specifically targets medical student or resident in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Ob/Gyn; dentists; nurse practitioners and Physician Assistants. Mental health professionals will be considered as space is available.

Site and student applications will be selected and finalized by an OSHPD-led Steering Committee which is composed from representatives of the following organizations:

- 1) OSHPD
- 2) California Primary Care Association (CPCA)
- 3) California Area Health Education Center (Cal-AHEC).
