Modalities: individually-oriented work with children with family/collateral component; some couples and whole families seen together. Also psychodiagnostic assessment. (School-based services in Oakland public schools, not part of post-doc activities.)

**Agency Mission /Objective:**

Ann Martin Center is a 501 (c)3 nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the lives of at-risk children, youth, and their families in Alameda County by providing psychotherapy, educational therapy and diagnostic assessment. Our mission is to provide high quality, psychodynamically informed psychotherapeutic services on a sliding scale basis to a diverse population of children, teens, adults and families. Ann Martin is committed to ongoing professional education and training for its staff and for professionals in the community.

Psychodynamic (with an emphasis on ego psychology and object relations), developmentally-grounded with attention to attachment, relational issues and environmental factors.

Children, adolescents, adults, families and some couples. Varied symptomatology and levels of functioning. Many single-parent families, high-conflict divorce cases, blended families, foster families, LGBT families, children and families dealing with bereavement and other traumatic events.

**Training and Education:**

Weekly seminars on Mondays and Wednesdays include: Child Psychotherapy Techniques, Dealing with Differences, Intake, Diagnosis and Treatment Planning, Psychological Assessment, Continuous Case Conference, Interns Seminar. Plus electives.

**X- Cultural Training:**

Weekly seminar, "Dealing with Differences" addresses racial, cultural, sexual, religious issues in addition to a variety of other areas that help increase awareness and sensitivity to diversity and differences.

**PostDoc**

Part-time: 10 clinical hours/week and 2 assessment cases/year. Full-time: 20 clinical hours and 3-4 assessments/year. Opportunities for supervision and/or administrative duties depending upon experience and interest.

**Prerequisites:**

Familiarity with and interest in psychoanalytic/dynamic theory and technique. Two years prior psychotherapy experience, preferably outpatient and experience with children/teens.
