Important Student Announcements:

Supervision Agreement Form: Must be filled out BEFORE you begin your clinical training in the internship. You should receive a copy of this form once it is completely executed, and an original should be retained in your file at the internship agency. Found on the CAPIC website at:

Verification of Experience Form: Completed at the conclusion of the training year by the internship agency and they will send an original of both forms to the California Board of Psychology. You should receive a copy of the Verification of Experience form also. Save both of these forms, along with the “Certificate of Completion” of your internship, in a file for the entire course of your professional career. Found on the CAPIC website at:

CAPIC Clearinghouse: CAPIC will open a Clearinghouse for any unfilled internship positions starting at Noon on April 5, 2010. Agencies that still have internship positions open will fill out CAPIC's Clearinghouse form and submit it to CAPIC. CAPIC will then post a list of open positions on our website, and send it to our doctoral program members to alert their students who are still looking for positions. The Clearinghouse Open Internship Positions List will be posted on the CAPIC website, on the "Students" page. Please contact CAPIC at capicadmin@capic.net if you have further questions.

Online Application and Computerized Matching: Please note that beginning next upcoming academic year of 2010-2011, CAPIC will begin using an online matching program for the internship application process. This means CAPIC programs will offer all of their internship positions through the CAPIC match. There will be a fee of \$100 for students applying to CAPIC internships next year.

CAPIC Violations Committee: If an offer is made to a student by a CAPIC program, it NEEDS to be accompanied by a written contract (following the verbal contract). If changes occur to the contract (eg. hours to be gained), they need to be documented. This is for your protection as a student!

Congratulations to the 31 interns who have been awarded the **CAPIC MHSA Stipend grants!** These interns were chosen from a large pool of deserving applicants, and we would like to thank everyone who applied.
