CAPIC BOARD OF DIRECTORS BOARD MEMBER CRITERIA: ELIGIBILITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES

SUPPLEMENTAL INFO FOR STUDENT/INTERN REPRESENTATIVES

Personal Characteristics

- Ψ Concern for CAPIC's development.
- Ψ Commitment to CAPIC's collaborative structure and processes.
- Ψ Commitment to community building through patience, tolerance, sense of humor, and good will.

Eligibility

- Ψ Student must be enrolled in a CAPIC Doctoral Academic Program. The academic program's membership in CAPIC must be current for a student/intern member to serve.
- Ψ Student nominations must be approved by their graduate program Director of Professional Training.
- Ψ Student must be at the doctoral internship level during their term, and must be serving at a CAPIC internship during their term (e.g. has an internship agreement/match for the upcoming training year).

Responsibilities

- Ψ Be informed about CAPIC's mission, activities and policies, and inform others about CAPIC.
- Ψ Attend all board meetings in their region (Northern or Southern California).
- Ψ Review agenda and supporting materials prior to meetings and participate in Board deliberations.
- Ψ Serve on a board committee and/or volunteer for special assignments within areas of expertise.
 - Assist with student/intern related tasks, as appropriate (e.g. Student Newsletter, Facebook, etc.).
- Ψ Adhere to conflict of interest and confidentiality policies.

Term-Commitment

- Ψ Serve as representative for one year (July 1 June 30).
 - o If a student is in a half-time internship and will subsequently serve a second one, she/he may be eligible to run for a second term as an Intern/Student board representative.

Benefits

Serving on the CAPIC board of directors gives students an excellent opportunity to learn, in-depth, about national, state and local training concerns. It also allows them to voice their own concerns, and those of their peers, about the internship training experience.
