

## **Native American Health Center (NAHC) Opportunities: Two full time, 1-year Fellowships**

Located in the San Francisco Bay Area, Native American Health Center (NAHC) is a community mental health clinic serving all residents of the surrounding areas. NAHC provides a holistic model of care, covering medical, dental, behavioral health, and traditional wellness through classes (e.g. beading, drumming, quilting) and providing access to traditional healers. The community we serve is richly diverse and historically underserved. Our adult and child clients commonly present with struggles around trauma, depression, anxiety, substance use and life stressors such as homelessness and family strife. We have a community psychology orientation with a primary treatment modality of cognitive behavioral therapy.

For the 2016-17 training year we are offering two full-time one year fellowship positions. This is a paid fellowship with a competitive stipend. The start date is flexible and can be as early as the end of June and as late as September 2016. Fellows will work with an interdisciplinary team of psychologists, MFTs, LCSWs, primary care providers, peer counselors, case managers and alcohol and drug counselors. In addition to receiving group and individual supervision, fellows will provide supervision (under a licensed psychologist) to a psychology practicum student. Fellows will participate in a weekly cultural seminar and supervision seminar to support their training. Some limited assessment experience is available in accordance with fellows' qualifications. In addition to their primary site of operations in the community mental health clinic, there is the potential for fellows to provide limited services at other sites such as school-based care, primary care, and behavioral health triage. Fellows will conduct intakes, and individual and group therapy.

We are particularly interested in therapists of color, Spanish-speaking therapists, and therapists with interest in and experience with treating trauma. No previous experience working with Native clients is necessary.
