Job Title: Bilingual/Bicultural Spanish-Speaking Psychological Assistant (Los Gatos, San Jose, Gilroy and Salinas areas). *Will also consider applications from English-speaking only applicants, with priority given to bilingual applicants. Duties of such a position will be similar, without expectation of Spanish-Speaking ability. Ability to speak Vietnamese, Mandarin, or Tagalog is considered a plus.*

### **Basic Function**

Psychotherapist will be competent to perform the following functions fully in Spanish and English: initial assessments and understanding of chronic pain clients, the cultural nuances of the Spanish speaking clients being able to convey cultural information relevant to treatment to the team, psycho-education for chronic pain clients, cognitive behavioral therapy and stress management groups, individual and family counseling, and working as an equal member within an interdisciplinary team in a medical clinic.

### **Responsibilities**

Psychotherapist will be responsible for the following duties:

- Individual, and group counseling sessions with Medicare, and worker's compensation patients
- Interviewing and assessing consultation clients
- Completing timely consult, progress and discharge reports on clients

### **Experience:**

Require psychotherapy experience with Spanish speaking populations with groups and individuals.

Understanding of, or willingness to learn, electronic health record entry.

Prefer some experience working with minority and under privileged clients, and those with chronic pain, and/or trauma.
