

Licensed Clinician Full Time

The Olympia House program is a 24 bed residential rehabilitation center and intensive outpatient program that provides high quality chemical dependency treatment services to adult men and women. The overarching goal of the program is to assist residents in attaining and maintaining a life free from chemical dependency. We are currently recruiting for a licensed clinician with experience in the treatment of substance abuse.

Under the supervision of the Clinical Director, the Clinician is responsible for implementing the clinical aspects of the program. The Clinician will provide direct clinical services, assure services are appropriately documented in compliance with all regulatory agencies, and assist in the operation of the overall program.

This position will be for 40 hours per week.

Specific Responsibilities

1. Provide clinical assessments, individual, family and group psychotherapy
2. Assure that all services are appropriately documented
3. Provide leadership and in-service training to other staff
4. Coordinate after care planning
5. Protect the rights of the individuals being served and maintain compliance with HIPAA regulations
6. Maintain a professional demeanor at all times and assist in assuring that all aspects of milieu have a recovery based focus
7. Oversee the development of all treatment plans to assure a recovery based focus with the direct input of the individual served in terms that are observable and measurable
8. Develop resources as necessary for the overall operations of the program
9. Assure that all services are provided in a culturally competent manner
10. Perform all other duties and responsibilities as assigned

Position Qualifications

1. A valid California Driver's license
2. Licensed in California as a Psychologist, Marriage Family Therapist, or Licensed Clinical Social Worker.
3. Knowledge of evidence based practices utilized in the treatment of chemical dependency
4. Knowledge of the effects of drugs of abuse including intoxication and detox symptoms
5. Knowledge of basic psychopharmacology
6. Competence in providing individual, family and group psychotherapy
7. Current First Aid/CPR Certification
8. Ability to physically assist individuals served in crisis situations

Employment is contingent upon proof of eligibility to work, 21 years of age or older, verification of degree/credentials, satisfactory health exam, submission of proof of California Driver's License, good driving record, successful completion of CPR and First Aid training, and agreement to uphold all Sonoma Recovery Services, LLC Policies and Procedures.
