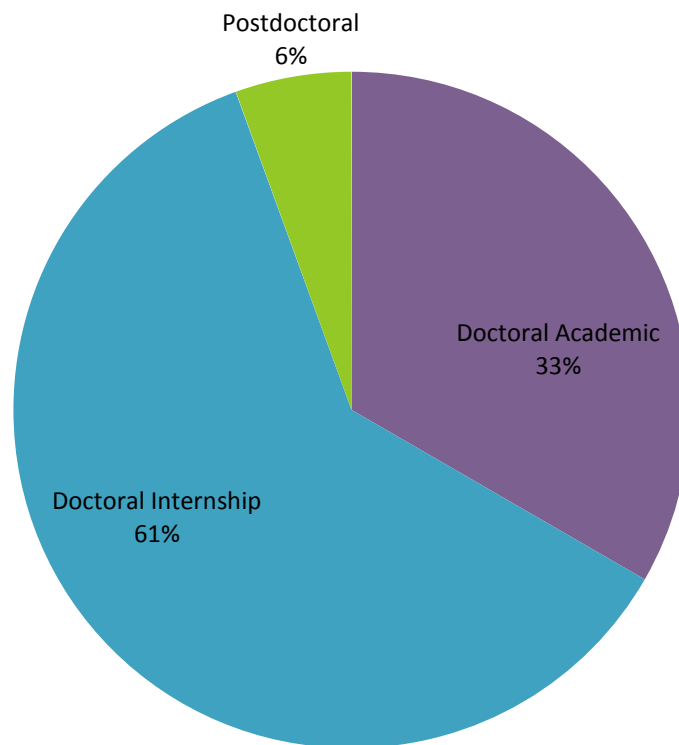


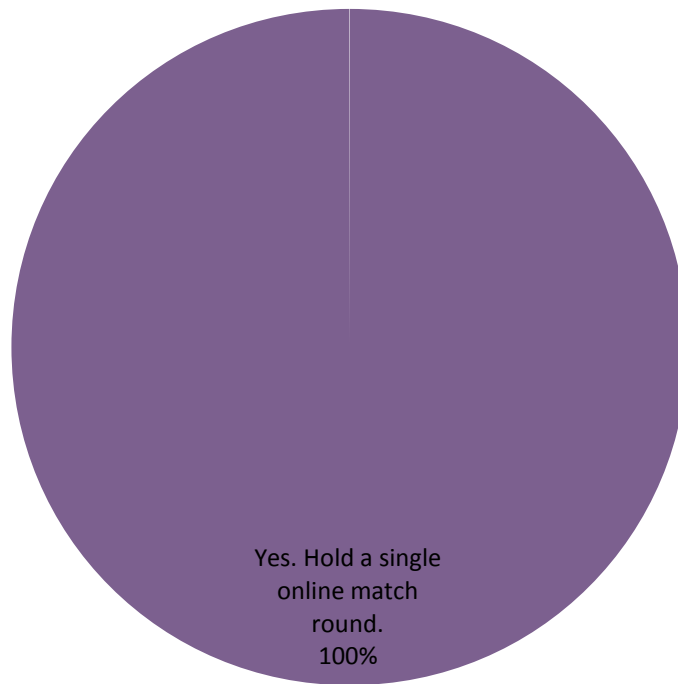
# Report for Possible Externship Training and 2017 CAPIC Online Match Poll

Which category of CAPIC Program Member are you representing here (Academic, Internship, Postdoc)?



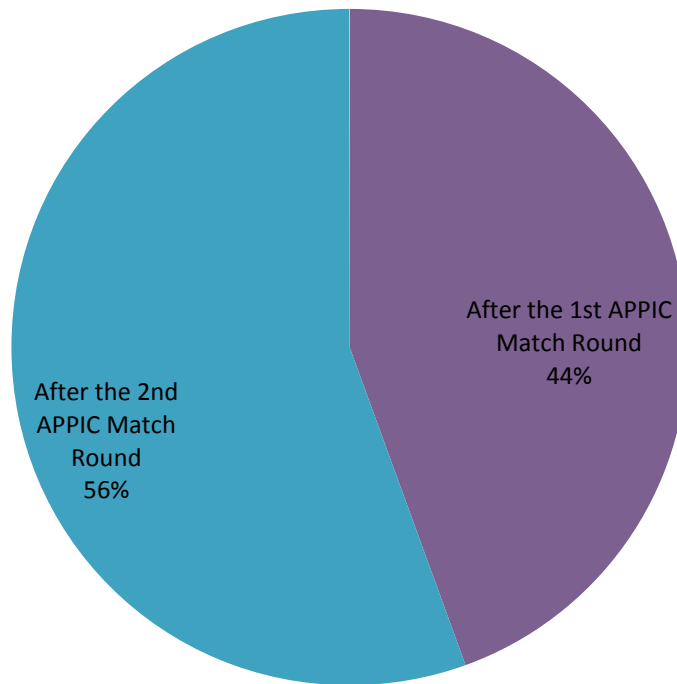

OVERALL MATCH SEQUENCE PROPOSAL: Should CAPIC again hold a single online match round, then go directly to Clearinghouse?



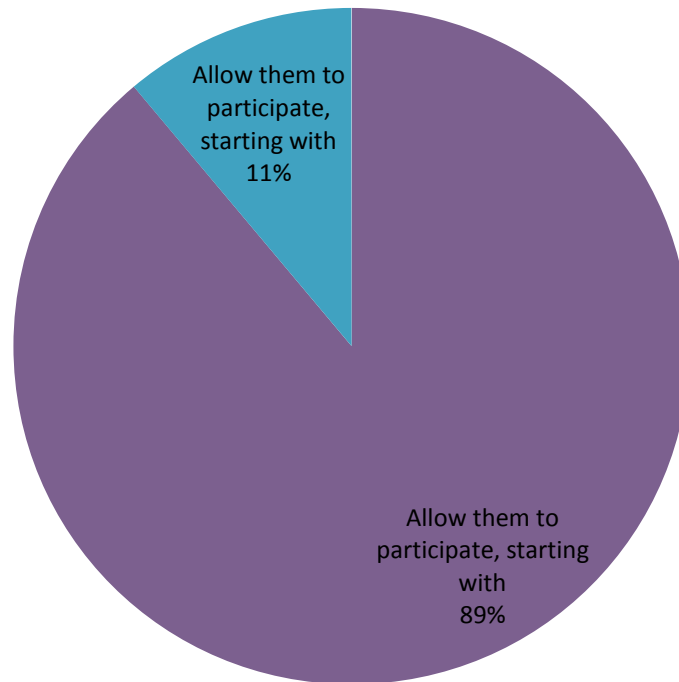

**MATCH TIMING PROPOSAL - TWO OPTIONS:** If we have only a single online match, should it occur after the 1st or the 2nd APPIC match round?



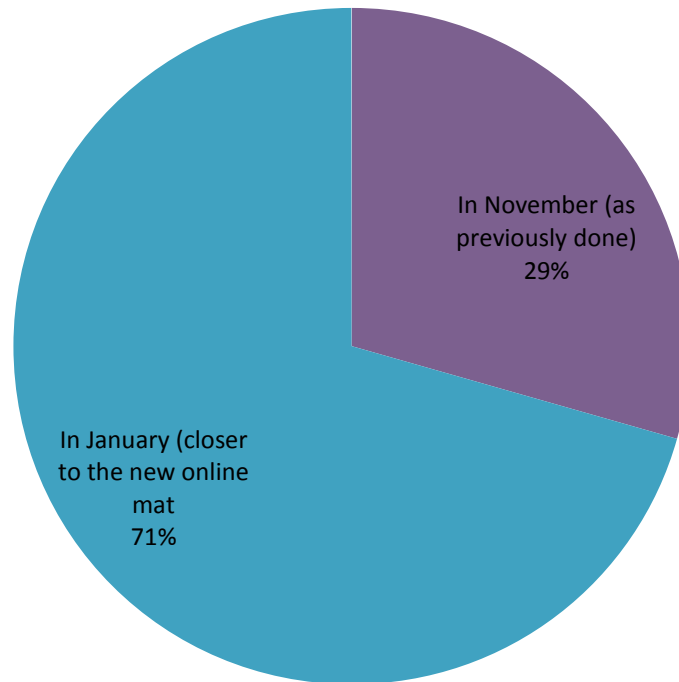

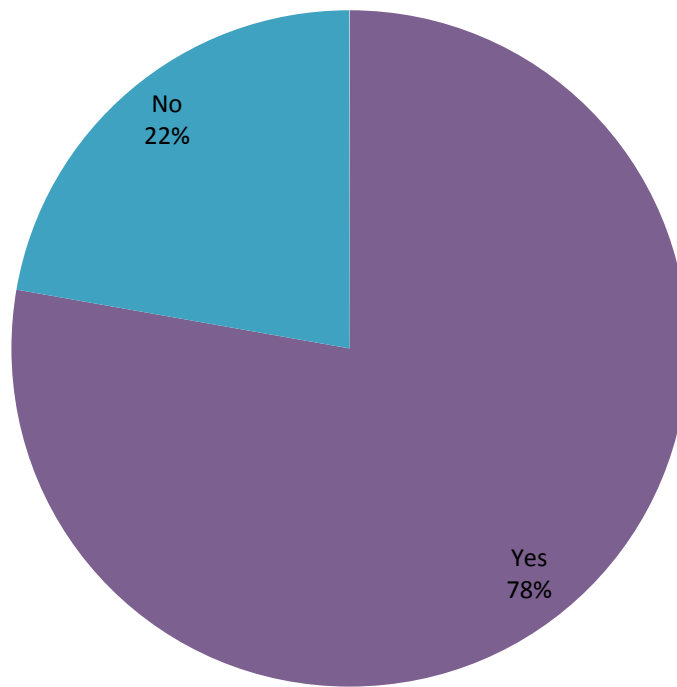

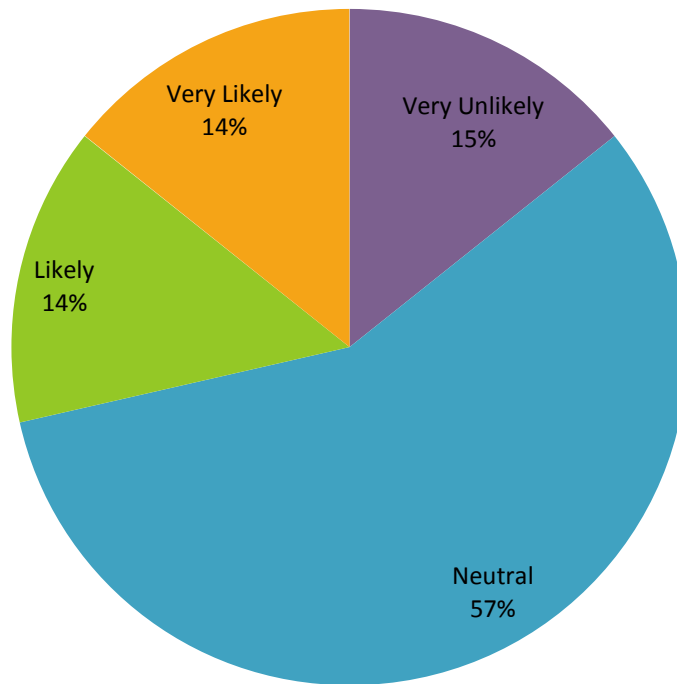

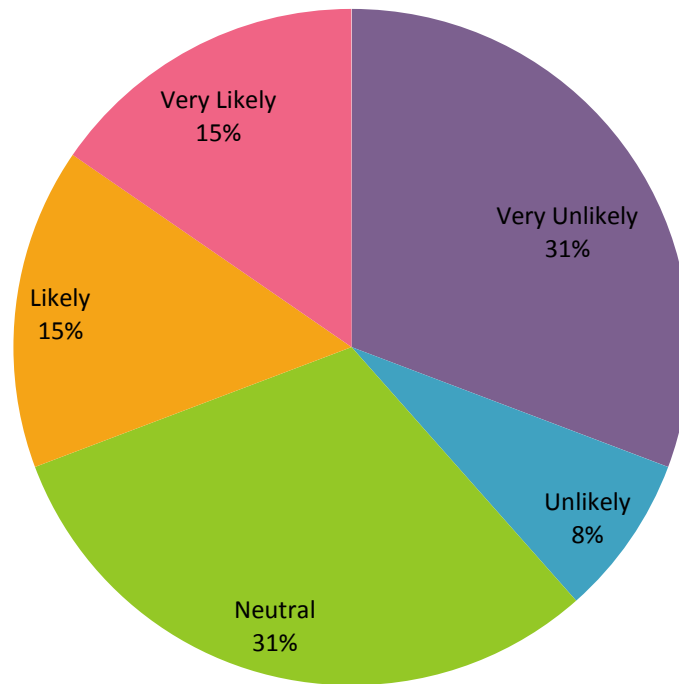

1	An Externship program is an excellent idea & a much needed service for students!
1	Haven't looked into the possibilities yet.
1	How are they different than a practicum? Would agencies have to apply for another membership category with fee, to be considered an Externship (hopefully not). I support opening up another option that could recruit more interns/externs.
1	Previous attempts by SCAPTP have been problematic on a number of fronts, including most notably secret deals and relationships between doctoral programs and practicum sites. I'm not sure if CAPIC means the same thing you say "post-practicum externship training." I don't know what that means.
1	Students are not adequately prepared for the level of pathology that exists on a college campus.
1	We made a decision to only accept CAPIC interns for pre-doctoral internships so we would not be participating (would definitely not participate if there is an additional cost for this).
1	While I voted YES in order to create more viability for CAPIC, I worry about this. I would not want a trend to develop whereby it became commonplace to add this extra piece to students who are already over-taxed financially and energetically. It could be conceived of as colluding with programs who make students who have not attained APA internships wait another year to apply again to APA internships. In my opinion, students typically receive very good training in practicum and internship and if they choose to specialize in a particular area, there are post-doctoral certificate programs and other types of specialized training they may engage in. Those are my candid thoughts on the externship idea.
