



CAPIC/MHSA Stipend Program

CAPIC Is Again Issuing 16 \$20K Stipends Under its MHSA Psychology Intern Program!

Basics:

- CAPIC will issue \$20,772 Full-Time stipends to sixteen (16) interns serving at qualified publicly-funded mental health sites in California.
- Stipend awardees will be announced by June 30, 2017, with funds to be distributed in the Fall.
- This CAPIC/MHSA psychology intern stipend program provides stipends to doctoral level psychology students who are committed to serving in public mental health.
 - This program is funded by the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA)/Prop 63.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must currently be enrolled at a psychology doctoral academic program in California.
- Students must currently be serving at a qualified internship.
 - A qualified internship is one which receives California county behavioral/mental health funds, but specifically excludes CDCR and State Hospital sites.
 - This internship must be the student's final internship prior to graduation, and the student must graduate by December of 2017.
 - Neither the school nor the internship need be CAPIC programs to qualify.
- Students must also be committed to working at a qualified postdoctoral site after graduation, and must commence this work within six months of graduation.
- Students must also complete fifteen (15) CAPIC/MHSA online training modules during the course of their internship and postdoctoral service.

Application Deadline: Extended to April 30, 2017
