2017-2018 Postdoctoral Fellowship Openings**

The Bay Area Psychological Services Center (PSC), the training clinic for the San Francisco campus of the California School of Professional Psychology, has openings for full time Postdoctoral Fellowship positions. Postdoctoral Fellows function in a leadership role to a team of Interns and Practicum trainees and provide direct services to adolescents at Bay Area school sites. Team Lead responsibilities include consultation with school administration, assignment of cases and administrative campus oversight of Intern and Practicum trainees. Direct services consist of individual and group therapy, crisis intervention and consultation. Teaching and supervisory experience are gained through co-leading case conference and group supervision and through presentations at didactic seminars.

Postdoctoral Fellows receive one (1) hour individual supervision and 2.5 hours group supervision weekly: Professional Development Seminar, Program Meeting/Process Group, and Team Lead Group Supervision. They participate in other training activities at the PSC including a weekly Didactic Seminar. Opportunities to conduct psychological assessments are available along with 1.5 hours of Assessment Group Supervision weekly.

The stipend for these positions is \$28,000 with eligibility for medical and dental coverage. There is a paid university winter break, additional school holidays, and 8 days of personal time off.

Diverse candidates are encouraged to apply. Alliant International University is an Equal Opportunity Employer and is committed to creating a diverse educational environment in which inclusion and equity are promoted.

About the Psychological Services Center:

The PSC was established in 1983 to support the California School of Professional Psychology's doctoral students in developing skills and competencies that are foundational to ethical, professional practice and to provide psychological services to the underserved in our community. Currently, the PSC provides mental health services to more than 300 people a year at schools throughout the Bay Area and through its assessment program. Our Internship program is fully accredited by the American Psychological Association.
