The 2017 CAPIC Board of Directors election ballot is attached for you to vote! Please VOTE!!!

How time flies! It is time to elect your CAPIC board representatives! Thanks to our current board members, as well as the new candidates seeking to serve on the CAPIC board. We also need the involvement of you, our members on and off the board, to remain relevant and responsive to you, our communities, and to the clients we ultimately serve. Thanks in advance for voting - and your ongoing participation.

Board members are elected for a three-year term on a rotating basis. The following four (4) CAPIC board positions are open for election this year:

- 1 NoCA Doctoral Internship Program Representative Position (3-year term)
- 1 NoCA At-Large Representative Position (3-year term)
- 1 NoCA Intern/Student Representative Position (1-year term)
- 1 SoCA Intern/Student Representative Position (1-year term)

We need your participation to ensure we have a great election - VOTE!

Please submit your vote/ballot by 5 pm on June 30, 2017.

VOTING OPTIONS: Paper (Traditional) or Online!

- Paper Ballot (Traditional Method)

- Print out the one-page election ballot
- Indicate (e.g. circle) your choices
- Print your name and your Program's name at the bottom of the ballot sheet
- Sign your name at the bottom of the ballot sheet
- Send it back to CAPIC by 5 pm on June 30, 2017.

- Follow analogous online instructions for properly submitting your ballot online.
- Submit it online by 5 pm on June 30, 2017

Active CAPIC Member programs (Doctoral Academic, Internship & Postdoctoral) are permitted one ballot/vote each.

- Only one person per Active Member program may cast a vote. Inactive programs are not eligible to vote.

- Program members determine for themselves who will act as their official representative, and training or field placement directors may designate another staff member to submit their program's ballot.
 - If multiple votes from the same program are submitted, the CAPIC office will communicate with the program to ensure only the proper ballot is counted.
 - If you represent multiple CAPIC Programs (e.g. an Internship and a Postdoc Program), they are considered separately, and each is entitled to one vote.

- The CAPIC office will then remove any identifying info, tally the votes, and submit the election results to the CAPIC Board for certification.
 - In the first week of July, the CAPIC office will announce the election results.
 - The term for newly elected Board members will start on July 1, 2017.
 - The first Board meeting of the new term will then be Sept 8th and 9th at JFK University in Pleasant Hill.
