 or field placement directors may designate another staff member to submit the ballot.
 - If multiple votes from the same program are submitted, the CAPIC office will communicate with the program to ensure only the proper ballot is counted.
 - If you represent multiple CAPIC Programs (e.g. an Internship and a Postdoc Program), they are considered separately, and each is entitled to one vote.
- The CAPIC office will then remove any identifying info, tally the votes, and submit the election results to the CAPIC Board for certification.
 - In the first week of July, the CAPIC office will announce the election results.
 - The term for newly elected Board members will start on July 1, 2015.
 - The first Board meeting of the new term will then be Sept 18 and 19th at JFKU in Pleasant Hill.
