Summary of Key Points for CAPIC and its 2017 Online Internship Match

For the CSPP San Diego Clinical Agency Fair Held on Friday, Dec 9, 2016

CAPIC internships provide a path to licensure and offer a wide variety of quality, local training opportunities for students (e.g. half-time vs full-time; theoretical orientations; services offered and populations served, etc.). - CAPIC currently has an imbalance of more internship positions than students, increasing the likelihood that students will match with their first CAPIC match choice. It's a students' market.
- To reduce this imbalance, CAPIC is reaching out to qualified doctoral academic programs and inviting them – and their students – to participate in the CAPIC match.

On June 22, 2016, CAPIC spoke before the US Department of Education's (DoE) National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI), about its concerns on the impact of APA/CoA policies on the profession and public. We believe policies such as the IR D-4-7(b) 50% threshold rule reduce diversity and disproportionately impact women and minority students and client populations. Our oral and written statements to the NACIQI are posted on the [Publications and Press](#) page of our website.

CAPIC continues to promote its existing postdoc programs and encourages its internships to develop CAPIC postdocs. See posted [promo material](#) on our website.

CAPIC has rolled out a post-practicum Externship program for (a) those students seeking additional training prior to Internship and (b) those CAPIC internships seeking to provide this training opportunity at their sites. The parameters are relatively flexible, while also requiring agreement between the internship and the student's doctoral academic program. CAPIC is again managing the MHPA Stipend Program for interns serving in public mental health, and will award sixteen \$20,772 stipends in 2017. The online application will open on February 10, 2017 and awardees will be announced in June. For more info, visit our [MHPA webpage](#).

CAPIC is also producing a poster depicting key measures of the diversity of its internships and students, from demographics, to theoretical orientations, community settings and populations served.

Key Points Specific to the 2017 CAPIC Online Internship Match:

1. CAPIC will again hold only one online match round, which will occur *after* the second APPIC Match results. Students may participate in both APPIC matches and then (if unmatched) in the CAPIC match.
2. Students may view internship profiles, without having to register or login, on the [CAPIC website](#).
3. Students may register (no fee) for the 2017 CAPIC match and start assembling their CAPIC application materials (\$100 fee for 15 applications) on the [CAPIC website](#). CAPIC will enable submission of completed application materials to specific internship programs or tracks on February 9th. The submission deadline then closes on February 27th. 4. The CAPIC Southern California Membership Meeting and Internship Fair will be held on Friday, February 3, 2017 at The Chicago School of Professional Psychology (TCSPP) – Los Angeles (617 West 7th Street, LA).
