NCSPP MidWinter Conference (January 16-20, 2017 in Long Beach, CA)

- CAPIC will present a symposium at the 2017 NCSPP MidWinter Conference at 3:15 pm on Jan. 19th.
 - The symposium panel is titled "Bringing diversity, inclusiveness, and social justice concerns to public awareness" and will discuss our efforts to promote these matters in the training of psychologists.
 - This symposium presentation is based on CAPIC's efforts before the US Department of Education's (DoE) National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI), regarding unintended consequences of APA/CoA policies on the profession and public. We believe policies such as the IR D-4-7(b) 50% threshold rule reduce diversity and disproportionately impact women and minority students and client populations.

MHSA Stipend Program:

CAPIC is again managing the MHSA Stipend Program for psychology interns serving in public mental health.

- CAPIC be awarding sixteen (16) stipends of \$20,772 each in 2017.
 - Students must, at the time of application, be enrolled at a California doctoral academic program AND be serving at a qualified internship.
 - Students must also be committed to working at a qualified postdoc for a year after graduation.
 - A qualified site is one which receives public mental health funds. CDCR and State Hospital sites are specifically not qualified sites under this program.

Key Points Specific to the 2017 CAPIC Online Internship Match:

- 1. CAPIC will again hold only one online match round, which will occur *after* the second APPIC Match results. Students may participate in both APPIC matches and then (if unmatched) in the CAPIC match.
 - We encourage our doctoral academic programs to consider CAPIC internships alongside APA and APPIC internships, and to consider the unique learning needs and professional goals of each individual student. More info on <u>CAPIC's unique place</u> is given on our website.
- 2. Internships should confirm the accuracy and readiness of their online profile (aka EAP) on the CAPIC website, particularly. More details are provided in previous newsletters and emails.
- 3. Students may view internship profiles, without having to register or login, here on the CAPIC website.
- 4. Students may register (no fee) for the 2017 CAPIC match and start assembling their CAPIC application materials (\$100 fee for 15 applications) on the <u>CAPIC website</u>.
- CAPIC will enable submission of completed application materials to specific internship programs or tracks on February 9th. The submission deadline then closes on February 27th. View the <u>2017 CAPIC</u> <u>Online Internship Match Schedule</u> for a summary of key dates.
