CAPIC Postdoc Programs,

How time flies! We are about to open our system for the 2018 CAPIC match.

We know that as CAPIC postdocs, you don't participate in our online match, but there are still a few system changes that affect you. There is also info on the APPIC Online Directory and Postdoc Selection Process that I'm sharing here.

I will also be sending out a separate email next week to you on other CAPIC matters (e.g. board meetings, future CAPIC projects).

1. **CAPIC has a new vendor for our online profiles/directory (Therasoft):** <https://programs.capic.net/>

○ **Next Tuesday, October 10th, your Postdoc program contact will receive an email invitation from Therasoft inviting you to log on to the new CAPIC online program directory.**

- Starting October 10th, all CAPIC profiles will be viewable and searchable here.
 - You will also login here to update/edit your program's profile.
- All data and docs from your existing CAPIC profile are being imported into this new profile format.
 - The format should be more user-friendly, for you and for students/applicants.
 - We are also hiding all email addresses behind a form, to prevent phishing by internet bots.
- **As we make this transfer from our old profile system to the new, we have had to prevent any changes to your profile on the existing CAPIC system as of yesterday.** My apologies for any inconvenience this maintenance may have caused you.
 - You can still view your profile, but you cannot make changes at this time.
 - When the new system goes online on October 10th, you will make profile changes/updates there.
- **After October 10th, you should review your profile for accuracy and completeness:**
 - Even if you previously reviewed your profile, please do so again in this new profile system, after October 10th. <https://programs.capic.net/>

▪ **Important:**

- This login is not the normal CAPIC website login. That is now obsolete and is being deactivated.

- Your email address now serves as your username.
 - For this new online profile/directory website (Therasoft <https://programs.capic.net/>), new passwords are needed.
 - You will have to select “Forgot Password” to generate a temporary password, and then login with it and select a new password. You can choose to use your old CAPIC password if you like.
- For those CAPIC postdoc programs that are also CAPIC internships, your email address will work for both programs.
 - You will be asked to select “Internship” or “Postdoc” when logging in (with Internship as the default).
 - Based on your selection, you will be taken to your desired profile for editing/updating.
 - See my separate email to CAPIC Internships for the more involved process for these internship programs (because they also have the online match procedures to manage).
- **This new directory will eventually have the capability of including profiles of interested postdoc APPLICANTS.** In this way, the postdoc directory can serve more as a self-regulated online matching service for postdoc sites and applicants, particularly outside of any other formal postdoc selection process.
- As you know, postdoc placement does not have a rigid timeline, or even a formal match process, although such efforts are underway. (See section below regarding APPIC efforts.)
- This ability to search and review potential postdoc sites and applicants would exist throughout the year. The match service aspect would ideally work outside of the timeframes for any formal selection process.

○ **Again, next Tuesday, October 10th, your Postdoc program contact will receive an email invitation from Therasoft inviting you to log on to the new CAPIC online program directory.**

Thanks for your understanding as we make this online system transition.

2. APPIC Online Directory and Postdoc Selection Process

Postdoc Directory:

- APPIC has recently developed a nationwide online Postdoc directory which includes some non-APA-accredited postdoc programs (e.g. CAPIC postdocs and others). This [Universal Psychology Postdoctoral](#)

[Directory \(UPPD\)](#) is available for use by students and programs for no charge.

- We encourage our CAPIC Postdoc members to list themselves in this directory as a means to reach a larger pool of quality applicants. A couple of our postdocs are already listed in the UPPD.

Postdoc Selection Process:

- APPIC also held its first nationwide postdoc match process last year, and to that end has developed a Postdoc Selection Process which currently may include non-APA-accredited postdoc programs (e.g. CAPIC postdocs and others).
- This process is not a requirement (yet); we simply ask you to consider it. Please visit their [website](#) and/or contact Dr. Wayne Siegel directly (Wayne.Siegel@va.gov) or more details on this [Postdoc selection process and guidelines](#) or the [postdoc directory](#).
