CAPIC/MHSA Psychology Intern Stipend Program Year 2 (2017-2018) Awardees Announced! June 30, 2018

The CAPIC/MHSA psychology intern stipend program is funded by the Mental Health Services Act (Prop 63). Under its previous MHSA contract, CAPIC has awarded \$4,121,185 in stipends to a total of 218 students.

In 2016, CAPIC was awarded a new contract from the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) to continue to provide stipends to doctoral level clinical psychology students who are committed to serving in the publicly funded mental health system in California

Under this new contract, CAPIC will distribute thirty-two (32) Full-Time (\$20,772) stipends awards. Last year, we awarded \$332,352 in full-time stipends to sixteen (16) awardees serving public health.

We are honored and proud to be able to advocate for psychology in public mental health settings these past several years, and we are especially proud of the students who have been a part of this important program.
